The Secret of the True Edge.

Take a measuring thread and from the very corner where the two sides meet, do this:

First sister: Count along one edge exactly 3 measures (three fingers or three needle lengths) and tie a knot.

Second sister: From the same corner along the other edge count exactly 4 of the same measures and tie the second knot.

The bond: Now stretch the thread between these two knots. If your corner is honest and right, then the distance between them will be exactly 5 of the same measures. No more, no less.
